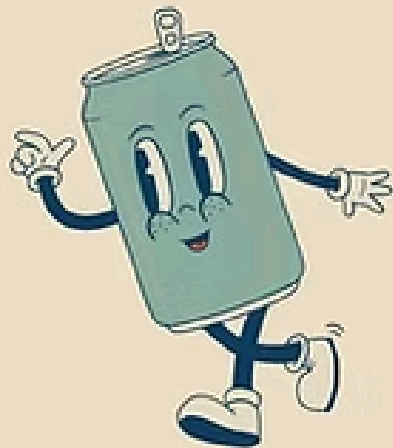

## Creamy Pasta Salad

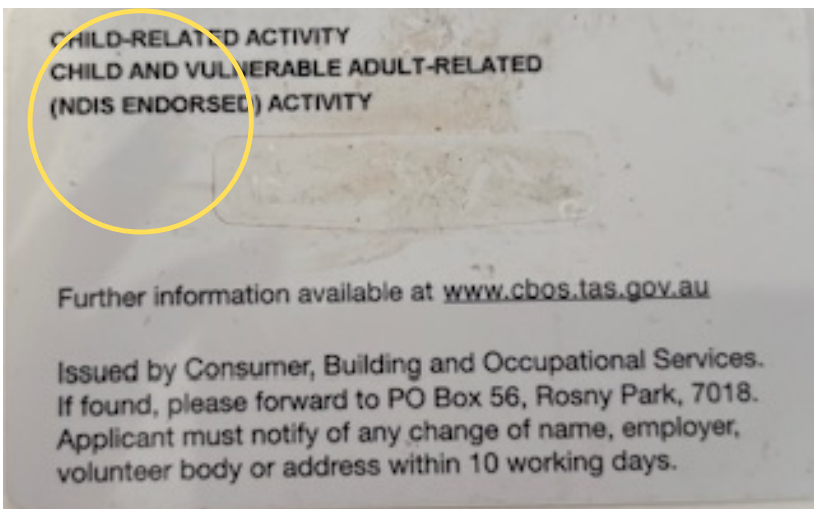
- 250g Pasta (uncooked)
- 1 Carrot grated
- 1 Celery chopped
- 1 Spring Onion (green stalk) finely chopped
- ½ Red Capsicum diced
- ⅔ cup Tasty Cheese
- ⅓ Cup Parsley finely chopped
- 300ml Coleslaw Dressing
- 3tbs Sour Cream

- Cook pasta in salted boiling water, drain then chill
- In a small bowl combine the coleslaw dressing and sour cream
- Combine pasta, vegetables and dressing mixture
- Chill before serving

# Attention All Volunteers



Due to recent changes to the Aged Care Act volunteers are now required to have current Working with Vulnerable People card which has a NDIS clearance along with a National Police Check (every three years)
