





Lemon Self Saucing Pudding

- 150g Melted Butter
- 2 tsp lemon rind finely grated
- 80ml Lemon Juice
- 315g Caster Sugar
- 115g Self Raising Flour
- 375ml Milk
- 4 Eggs, Seperated

- Preheat Oven to 180/160 Fan forced
- Grease six 250ml Oven proof dishes or teacups
- Place the butter, lemon juice, lemon rind, sugar, flour, milk and egg yolks in a bowl. Whisk to combine.
- Use electric beaters to beat egg whites on high until soft peaks form.
- Use a metal spoon to fold onequarter of the egg white into the lemon mixture.
- Gently fold in the remaining egg white.
- Spoon mixture into prepared dishes and place in a large baking dish. Pour enough boiling water into baking dish to come halfway up the sides of the smaller dishes.
- Bake for 25-30 minutes or until golden and just set. Dust with icing sugar, top with cream and sprinkle with extra zest
